SIMULATED COMMITTEES & THEMATIC AGENDAS

THE SIMULATION AGENDAS ARE CLOSELY ALIGNED WITH INDIA'S NATIONAL CYBER POLICY FRAMEWORKS AND THE 10 CORE INNOVATION DOMAINS DEFINED UNDER ISEA PROJECT.

1. **UNGA** - DISEC (United Nations General Assembly - Disarmament & International Security Committee)

Agenda: International Cooperation to Prevent Cyber Warfare, Regulating Digital Weapons, and State Sovereignty.

Scope & Focus: Delegates will debate international cybersecurity governance standards, focusing on state-sponsored cyber operations, cross-border ransomware mitigation, and establishing a zero-trust policy architecture for global critical infrastructure.

2. **UNHRC** (United Nations Human Rights Council)

Agenda: Data Privacy, State Surveillance, and Gender-Responsive Digital Safety.

Scope & Focus: Focuses on the ethical boundaries of surveillance, AI-driven data collection, and protecting vulnerable groups online. Special attention will be given to rural cyber-literacy models and digital gender equity initiatives such as the e-SafeHER project.

3. **IP** (INTERNATIONAL PRESS)

Agenda: Journalistic Integrity, Fact-Checking, and Real-Time Media Coverage.

Scope & Focus: Serving as the official journalistic body. Student journalists will draft critical editorials, capture photography, conduct live press conferences, and run the rapid 2-day conference newsletter operations.

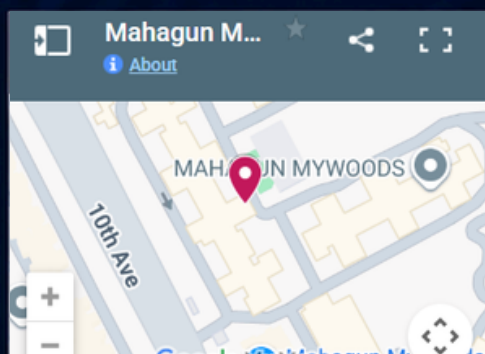
